This Addendum shall become a part of the plans and specifications for the above named project and its receipt shall be acknowledged on the bid form and on the outside of the Bidder's envelope.

1) REFER TO 31 2000 EARTH MOVING par. 3.3 and DRAWINGS SHEETS A100

- a) Item #1:
 - i) Contractor's option - the existing 14,500 gallon fuel tank may be opened on site and cleaned with dry ice or other methods meeting EPA approval prior to disposal in an approved landfill.
 - ii) The existing UG fuel lines from the UG tank to the building may be abandoned in place. The lines shall be filled with an inert slurry fill material and shall be capped at both ends, at the building and at the tank.
- b) Item #2:
 - i) Contractor's option - the existing 500 gallon fuel tanks may be opened on site and cleaned with dry ice or other methods meeting EPA approval prior to disposal in an approved landfill.
 - ii) The existing UG fuel lines from the three 500 gallon tanks to the pump island may be abandoned in place. The lines shall be filled with an inert slurry fill material and shall be capped at both ends.
